

Metallized labels

Definition

- A metallized paper is obtained by a thin aluminium layer evaporated onto the varnished paper (vacuum process).
- A metallized label is achieved by printing transparent or opaque inks on the metallized surface.

Advantages

- Optimal metallic effect
- Good opacity, especially in wet conditions
- Sustained white
- Optimal control against wrinkling
